

Killeen Small Business Grant – Ineligible Businesses

The following is a list of ineligible businesses for the Killeen Small Business Grant assistance program. This list is not all inclusive. Businesses not eligible:

- Franchisors, Regional or National chains
- Real estate offices, developers, investors
- Governmental/taxing agencies/departments
- Hobby businesses as defined by federal law
- Home based businesses
- An individual who employs household employees such as nannies or housekeepers
- A business that is otherwise prohibited by federal or state law
- Bingo/Sweepstakes/Gambling operations, including casinos, racing and other activities whose purpose involves gambling or similar form of gambling
- Adult or sexually oriented businesses (live performances, product sales, items, or materials)
- Businesses primarily engaged in lending, investments or to an otherwise eligible business engaged in financing or factoring
- A business where a 20% or more equity owner is incarcerated, on probation, on parole; presently subject to an indictment, criminal information, arraignment, or other means by which formal criminal charges may be brought in any jurisdiction; or has been convicted of a felony within the last five (5) years
- Businesses engaged in illegal activities under federal, state or local laws
- A business that is ineligible or precluded from receiving federal or State of Texas funding (including but not limited to CARES Act) due to violation of federal or Texas Laws (debarment/suspension)
- Businesses determined to be essential as defined by the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CIAS)
- Social Clubs
- Gun Shops
- Pawn Shops
- Alcohol and Liquor Retail Shops
- Cannabis/Vape/Smoke shops
- Multilevel marketing companies
- Lobbying and political organizations
