PUBLIC INPUT NEEDED FOR PARKS MASTER PLAN SURVEY

(KILLEEN, TEXAS): The City of Killeen is seeking public input in the development of a Parks and Recreation Master Plan. Adults and youth are encouraged to participate by taking an online survey at www.killeentexas.gov/parks.

“This master plan will create the playbook for the fun you can have in our community,” says Brett Williams, executive director of community services. “We are developing this plan to establish immediate and long-range goals in facilities and programs. Public participation in the process is extremely important so that we know what the people who recreate in our community need and want.”

There are two versions of the online survey. The adult survey is intended for participants age 18 and up, and the youth survey is for those younger than 18. The survey is open through November 23, and participants will be entered for a variety of prizes for completing it.

The public is invited to a community open house about the master plan November 16 from 6 to 8 p.m. at Killeen Civic & Conference Center, 3601 S. WS Young Drive.
