

Visibility At Intersections

City of Killeen Code of Ordinance, Section 28-241

Visibility triangle shall mean a triangle sight area, at all intersections, which shall include that portion of public right-of-way and any corner lot within the adjacent curb lines and a diagonal line intersecting such curb lines at points thirty-five (35) feet back from their intersection (such curb lines being extended if necessary to determine the intersection point).

It shall be unlawful to set out, maintain or permit or cause to be set out or maintained any tree, shrub, plant, sign or other view obstruction having a height greater than two (2) feet as measured from the top of the curb of the adjacent streets within the visibility triangle. The restriction shall not apply to permanent structures authorized by the zoning ordinance or to traffic-control signs and signals, street signs or utility poles placed within such area by authority of the city council.
