Mickey's Dog Park Improvements


- Fence repaired completed May 2021

- Pour concrete under pavilions Fall 2021












Visits to the Dog Park

What prevents you from visiting the Dog Park?


- Grass needs cut and dog poo not picked up by others

- Need a smaller place for the tiny ones


What prevents you from visiting the Dog Park?

- Aggressive dogs


Is there adequate seating?




Quality of agility/obstacles




Should small dogs be allowed in the large dog area




Quality of shade structures
